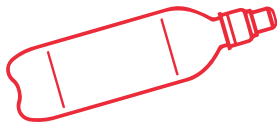

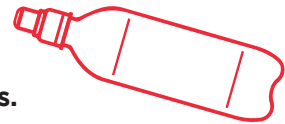


Through our global supply chains, we have been able to secure much needed PPE for use by front line workers. We donated
